## AUTHORIZED ACCESS: seeking information

privacy and security

A webinar/seminar to help minimize online risks to children and the family

Senior (Grades 9-12) 45 mins Intermediate (Grades 6-8) 40 mins Junior (Grades 3-5) 35 mins

Everyone in society is part of or interacts with various groups of people. Kids are part of family, friends and school groups, while routinely interacting directly or indirectly with government, law and businesses. Additional groups undesirable to be part of or interact with include bullies, thieves and predators. An examination of active privacy laws that protect citizens of Canada and how social networking providers' terms of service necessarily conflict with these protections.

In context and detail appropriate for each demographic, all attendees explore the risks and safeguards relating to these topics: Legal minimum user age of 13; providers' terms of service; providers' possession of users' 'private' information; the two types of online content; rationalizations for carelessness and risk-taking; predators' motivations and methods; app permissions, locations services, account settings and passwords.

Intermediate and senior students' sessions include examples of the traditional and recently enacted laws that punish those who engage in common but illegal online behaviour. Parents & caregivers learn: How to recognize a "phishing" email, the dangers of using public WiFi, parental controls' considerations plus messaging privacy options.
